"The Diocese recognises each child as a gift from God, and values and encourages the participation of all children in all activities that enhance their spiritual, physical, emotional, intellectual and social development.

What does 'Children's Liturgy of the Word' mean?

The term 'Children's Liturgy of the Word' refers to the practice of children leaving the Sunday Mass during the Liturgy of the Word and gathering in a nearby room (e.g. Oratory) to celebrate a separate Liturgy of the Word that is more appropriate to their level of understanding.


Sign-in Book to be signed by...

Children's Liturgy Leaders should sign-in, date and record the names of the children present.

General Guidelines

- A Consent Form should be completed by parents/guardians for all children in the Children's Liturgy.
- Codes of Behaviour for Adults and Young People are made available.
- Appropriate supervision ratios should be maintained at all times—think of how many adults are needed to supervise the activity.
- Make sure that the facilities are safe and do not pose any dangers.
- Remember that:
