All altar servers should complete a consent form signed by their

parents/guardians.

- Alter servers must have written Parental Consent if they are to leave school to serve mass and provision should be made to ensure that they arrive and return to school
- All Sacristies should have a fully stocked first aid kit in case of accidents
- Incident report forms should be filled out in the event of any accidents that occur.
- Codes of Behaviour for Adults & Young People are made available.
- Adults should be aware that being alone with a young person is not appropriate practice—if you cannot avoid being alone with a young person make sure that there is a door onen at all times.
